We use a range of assessments and reporting methods throughout the year at Bun-sgoil Taobh na Pàirce to keep you informed about your child's progress, achievements and next steps in learning.



Meet the Teacher

At the start of the school year, it provides an opportunity to learn about the curriculum, homework expectations, and classroom routines and approaches.



Parent Consultations

Individual meetings held twice a year in November and May. We discuss your child's progress across the curriculum, strengths, achievements and next steps in learning.



Report

The report card provides a summary of your child's progress and achievements, clear next steps, and whether your child is on track to achieve expected learning outcomes for their stage.

This jotter provides you with examples of your child's work completed in class. This allows you to see learning in action and gain a better understanding of classroom learning experiences.



Learning Journals
